

## Gerry Coker – Hall of Fame Inductee

Gerry Coker was a designer for the Donald Healey Motor Company, he was responsible for the design of the Austin-Healey 100 and Sprite, later joining Chrysler and the Ford Motor Company, where he invented the 3-postion tailgate.

Gerry will be inducted into the British Sports Car Hall of Fame on June 2, 2017.

*Gerald Charles Coker, known to all as “Gerry,” was born June 24, 1922 in Northamptonshire, England. He is known in the Healey world for his body design of the Healey Hundred introduced in 1952. Gerry’s design talent showed up early in life with his childhood “doodles” of motorcars.*

*He began his training as an engineer in 1939 when he apprenticed at the Rootes Group, where he worked with experimental designs for armored vehicles and other military vehicle components prior to and during WWII.*

*He joined the Donald Healey Motor Company as Healey’s body engineer in 1950. His first job was to look after the Nash Healeys as they came from Panelcraft, the Nash Healey body makers.*

*Early on at the DHMC, Healey challenged Gerry to show him a sports car design, and in late 1950, he created the body design for what would become the Austin-Healey 100. This timelessly beautiful sports car stole the show in October, 1952 when it debuted as the Healey Hundred at the London Motor Show at Earls Court.*

*Gerry also styled the Austin-Healey Streamliner (the “pretty one,” he says) that was driven to 192.7 mph at the Bonneville Salt Flats in 1954 while establishing records in speed and endurance. And just before moving on from the DHMC, Gerry developed the preliminary body design for the forthcoming Austin-Healey Sprite, which made its very successful first appearance in 1958. Budget considerations caused the Sprite’s final design to be altered considerably. This early design did not include the unique headlamps which caused the first Sprites to be called “Bugeye” in North America and “Frogeye” in Great Britain.*

*Gerry and his wife, Marion, were wed in June, 1953 near Coventry, Warwickshire. Their engagement coincided with Gerry’s design work for the Healey Hundred. Their wedding almost didn’t take place, as that June weekend was also the race weekend at Le Mans. Donald Healey had entered four cars (two Austin-Healeys and two Nash Healeys) and wanted Gerry to attend the race. He did not. Marion recalls that “I won that one!”*

*In 1957, the Cokers left England for life in America. Gerry worked at the Chrysler Corporation for about five years before a move to the Ford Motor Company, where he worked until 1987, when he retired as a Senior Product Design Engineer. It was Gerry who designed the famous dual action tailgate for station wagons; he and Ford hold a patent on his ingenious design.*

*Gerry and Marion Coker are familiar faces to most Healey club members who have met them over the years at various Austin-Healey meets. Currently the Cokers reside in Sarasota, Florida and remain active at local and regional Austin-Healey gatherings.*

*When you see an Austin-Healey, you can thank Gerry Coker for its timeless design.*



## Rocker Cover Racing

The Austin Healey Association of Southern California has agreed to conduct the Rocker Cover Racing event at the 2017 Monterey International Healey Week. We strongly urge all attendees to compete in this event, and this article will tell you how you can.

What is Rocker Cover Racing? It is where grown adults (?) relive their soap-box derby childhood hobby, but instead of building and driving the car downhill, they build and race real car valve covers (AKA Rocker Covers) down an incline track. Both activities involve competition, design & construction skills, creativity and speed.

The AHASC began Rocker Cover Racing as a regular event of California Healey Week in 2011 after member Edwin Neumeyer returned from Australia. There, he attended a Healey show where the Aussies enthusiastically conducted this event during cocktail hour. Ed came home with the rules and the winning trophy and the rest is history. Today, we have fun building, displaying and racing rocker covers each year. If you Google this topic, you'll see that several other car clubs across the U.S. do this also.

The rules for Rocker Cover Racing (see attached) govern the building and racing of the cars. **Essentially, the participant only needs to acquire a BMC valve cover and attach wheels.** The AHASC has found that the best wheels are made by cannibalizing 3 ½ inch computer hard disks, which we can provide for \$5 each. Old valve covers can be found for under \$20. Thus, a participant can build a rocker racer for under \$40. Many members also creatively decorate the cars by painting, and adding decals and other decorations.

At Healey Week, we have two basic activities and awards are offered for both; Best Presentation (i.e., Best of Show) and Fastest Car. The Best Presentation is where show attendees can vote on their favorite car. The Fastest Car is the rocker cover racer that wins the single elimination competition on the incline track.

## **ROCKER COVER RACING REGULATIONS**

*The Rocker Cover Racers will be released at the top of a ramp, and will then continue along an approximately 20' to 30' track. Each race will include two racers at a time. The Rocker Cover Racers can be Austin Healey 4 or 6 cylinder or other BMC Engine Rocker/Valve Covers with wheels attached.*

*THE FIRST TO PASS THE FINISH LINE WINS!*

### **CLASS I – FASTEST RACER**

### **CLASS 2 - BEST PRESENTED**

#### **The Course:**

- The course shall consist of a track approximately between 20' to 30' in length.
- The course will include launch incline followed by a lesser running incline with a catching soft material at the end.
- The track will be divided into two lanes. • The start will be by means of a manually operated release bar.
- The finish line will be clearly defined by a line on the track.
- The track is divided down the middle to prevent racers from colliding and has edging to prevent the racers leaving the track.

#### **The Race:**

- Cars run in heats of two cars, in either one off elimination rounds or in a round robin format subject to the number of entries.
- The cars are launched with their front against the starting mechanism bar.
- The race will be started by release bar by an independent operator.
- The first car across the finishing line will be deemed the winner.
- If neither car crosses the finish line then the car travelling the farthest on the track will be the winner.
- Winning cars will advance to the next round until all but the winning racer is eliminated.

#### **The Racer Build Regulations:**

- The car shall be built from either an Austin Healey 4 or 6 cylinder or other BMC engine **STEEL** rocker/valve cover.
- No aerodynamic aids can be added to the rocker covers.
- Oil filler caps shall **NOT** be removed.
- The overall height of the original tappet cover must **NOT** be altered.
- Stud holes may be used to secure the axle and wheel assemblies.
- The oil breather tubes on rocker covers **MAY** be removed.
- Racers shall have a minimum of 3 wheels with non metallic tires/contact points with the track.
- The cars shall **NOT** have any additional power source whatsoever.
- Dimensions of rocker covers must remain as produced.
- The diameter of the wheels must not exceed 7 7/8".
- Wheels may be either within or outside the cover.
- Maximum width of the racer, including wheels is 8 1/4".
- Maximum weight of the racer is 6 5/8 LBS.
- The front wheels must not extend beyond the front of the cover.
- No electrical or magnetic devices may be used on the covers
