The Bay Area is home to a bunch of private car collections but the Al Engel Collection is truly one of the greatest!

Housed in a massive non-descript four-building complex in Richmond/San Pablo the collection includes vintage American and European cars, race cars and unique Hot Rods. But, also rare engines including a WW II Merlin V12, Offenhauser race engines, a Rolls-Royce jet engine, vintage Hemis, Ford Flatheads some with Ardun OHV conversions, and waaay more. Then there's the Aviation and Military equipment including a Fokker DR-1 tri-wing and other airplanes, a Korean War Willys M38 jeep and rare American Bantam military vehicles. And then there are the motorcycles (American, British, Italian, and more). A person could drown in motor oil at this place. But what a way to go!

So, on November 7th at 9 am SHARP we're going to leave the Michael's parking lot (60 Gregory Ln, Pleasant Hill) for a 30-mile drive through the East Bay hills to get to Al's collection (2801 Giant Hwy Building A, San Pablo).
